For people living with dementia, brain injuries, mental health needs or learning disabilities, good sleep can make daily life more stable, more predictable and more engaging.

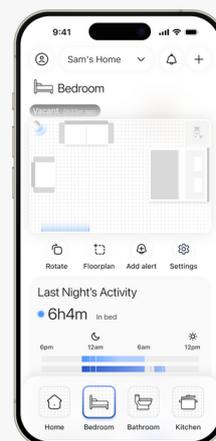
The problem with traditional night checks
